Open channel for necessary early check-ins, all areas.
(Call twice with "any relays?")

Roll Call

Open channel for late members and visitors.

Handle:

1. Message form traffic
2. Contacts (limit 3 minutes if on frequency).
3. Phone calls.
4. Phone patches (off frequency or after net).
